sexuality and relationships.

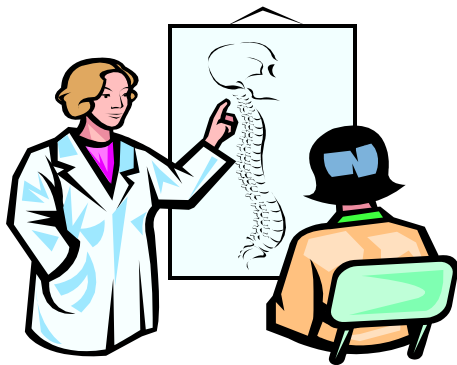


We all face challenges of creating environments that support and nurture sexual health. This program helps youth face the challenges surrounding attitudes, values, and feelings in a respectful environment.

The Unitarian Universalist Association and the United Church of Christ have developed this program completely free of religious doctrine or reference.

Program Highlights:

- **Anatomy** - learn male and female body parts.
- **Body Image** - How our culture impacts every person's self-image. Challenge the social media portrayal of sexual behavior as violent, sleazy, dirty, manipulative, and absent of responsibility. Understand media's and advertising's effect on body image.
- **Gender and Sexual Orientation** - identify the difference between gender identity and sexual identity, explain heterosexuality, homosexuality, and bisexuality, explore what homophobia is and its impact, explain the myths about gay, lesbian, and bisexual people.



- **Relationship Skills** - identify what qualities make a healthy relationship, build communication skills for dating and other relationships, focus on direct communication, and practice how to ask and refuse dates.



- **Masturbation & Lovemaking**- examine myths about masturbation and lovemaking and create a discussion for youth to ask questions about sexual behaviors.
- **Contraception and Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI's)** - information about all forms of birth control and their effectiveness, understanding how infections are transmitted, causes, and prevention.
- **Sexual Harassment** - how to identify and avoid date rape, identification of sexual abuse, discuss domestic violence and abuse and how to avoid it.
